



**Minutes of the Mission Directorate Meeting of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the UT Government of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu (2024-25)**

The Mission Directorate Meeting of National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2024-25 was held through Video Conferencing on 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 at 3.30 P.M. at Charak, Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha, Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India, to discuss the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of UT Government of **Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu**. The list of the participants is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

2. At the outset, Ms. Kavita Garg, Joint Secretary, Ayush welcomed the representatives of UT Government to the Mission Directorate meeting and briefed that the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu had already been appraised during the Appraisal Committee meeting and detailed observations and recommendations were communicated in principal to the UT Govt. of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu. Further, it was also informed to the Mission Directorate that during the Appraisal Meeting, a detailed review of progress of Expenditure had been carried out. It was suggested by Joint Secretary that as per issued guidelines of Dept. of Expenditure, State/UT Government has to fulfil the following pre-conditions to get grants under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of NAM.

- (i) Achievement of 75% of expenditure.
- (ii) Submission of at least 75% of utilization certificates against the UCs due
- (iii) Funds available in the bank account of SNA is to be less than 12.5% of the total approval including State Share.
- (iv) State/UT has to release both Central and State share within 30 days to SNA and interest will be charged beyond lapse of 30 days.
- (v) No funds lying in Treasury
- (vi) Refund of accrued interest

In this regard, it was observed that, UT has to focus on submission of UCs at least 75% against the UCs due, SNA balance should to be less than 12.5% of approved amount and refund of accrued interest. Accordingly, UT Government has been requested to fulfill the conditionalities at the earliest and in response UT representatives informed that all conditionalities will be complied within 15 days.

3. Mission Directorate reviewed the implementation of the National Ayush Mission activities in the U.T. Govt. of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu. Details of review are as follows:

**(i) Overall Release, Expenditure and Utilization Certificates** status was reviewed and observations are as follows:

- a. **Status of Release & Expenditure:** Out of **Rs. 892.698 lakhs** sanctioned as central from 2014-15 to 2023-24, UT Govt. has reported an expenditure of **Rs. 513.690 lakhs (57.54 %)** against Central share.

- b. **Status of Utilization Certificates:** UT has submitted UCs for an amount of **Rs.412.57 lakh (57.33%)** against the total UCs due of **Rs.719.70 lakh**
- c. **SNA balance** as on 17.09.2024 = Rs. Rs. 403.42 lakhs.

**(ii) Status of Ayushman Arogya Mandir (Ayush):-**

- i) Total Units of AAM- Ayush approved: - **01**
- ii) Total Units of AAM Ayush functional: -**01**
  - a) Physical Reported: **Yes (01)**

4. During Mission Directorate, discussion was held with UT representatives of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu based on the recommendations of the Appraisal Committee regarding State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of UT Government of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu for the year 2024-25. Accordingly, Mission Directorate approved the SAAP for an amount of **Rs. 1381.460 Lakhs** as Central Share against the resource pool of Rs. 1035.000 lakhs (**Annexure-II**), subject to condition that UT Government has to fulfill the conditions as stipulated in guidelines issued by Department of Expenditure from time to time regarding procedure for release of funds under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) and monitoring utilization of the funds. The detailed component/activity wise approval of the Mission Directorate meeting is enclosed below (**Annexure-III**).
