Minutes of the Mission Directorate Meeting of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the State Government of Karnataka for the year 2024-25

The Mission Directorate Meeting of National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2024-25 was held through Video Conferencing on 26thJuly 2024 at 12.00 P.M. under the Chairmanship of Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha, Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India, to discuss the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of State Government of **Karnataka**. The list of the participants is enclosed as **Annexure-I.**

- 2. At the outset, Ms. Kavita Garg, Joint Secretary, Ayush welcomed the representatives of State Government to the Mission Directorate meeting and briefed that the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of Karnataka had already been appraised during the Appraisal Committee meeting and detailed observations and recommendations were communicated in principal to the State Govt. of Karnataka. Further, it was also informed to the Mission Directorate that during the Appraisal Meeting, a detailed review of progress of Expenditure had been carried out. It was suggested by Joint Secretary that as per issued guidelines of Dept. of Expenditure, State/UT Government has to fulfil the following pre-conditions to get grants under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of NAM.
 - (i) Achievement of 75% of expenditure.
 - (ii) Submission of at least 75% of utilization certificates against the UCs due
 - (iii) Funds available in the bank account of SNA is to be less than 12.5% of the total approval including State Share.
 - (iv) State/UT has to release both Central and State share within 30 days to SNA and interest will be charged beyond lapse of 30 days.
 - (v) No funds lying in Treasury
 - (vi) Refund of accrued interest

In this regard, it was observed that, State has to focus on funds available in the bank account of SNA should not be more than 12.5% of the approved amount. Accordingly, State Government has been requested to fulfill the conditionalities at the earliest and in response State representatives informed that all conditionalities will be complied soon.

- 3. Mission Directorate reviewed the implementation of the National Ayush Mission activities in the State. Govt. of Karnataka. Details of review are as follows:
- (i)Overall Release, Expenditure and Utilization Certificates status was reviewed, and observations are as follows:
 - a. **Status of Release & Expenditure**: Out of **Rs. 33405.366 lakhs** sanctioned from 2014-15 to 2023-24 including Central & State Share and State Govt. has reported an expenditure of **Rs. 27821.153 lakh (83.28%)**.
 - b. Status of Utilization Certificates: State has submitted UCs for an amount of Rs 16653.7 lakh (83.10%) against the total UCs due of Rs. 20041.17 lakhs.

- c. SNA balance as on 05.08.2024 =Rs. 4628.92lakh.
- (ii) Status of Ayushman Arogya Mandir (Ayush):
 - i) Total Units of AAM (Ayush) approved: 376
 - ii) Total Units of AAM (Ayush) functional: -376 (216-in functional Stage I & 160- in functional Stage II)
 - a) Physical Reported: 376
 - b) No. of AAM (Ayush) assessed for ALEC by NABH:-50
 - c) No. of AAM (Ayush) certified for ALEC by NABH:-50
 - d) Reported in Portal: 376
- 4. During Mission Directorate, discussion was held with State representatives of Karnataka based on the recommendations of the Appraisal Committee regarding State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of State Government of Karnataka for the year 2024-25. Accordingly, Mission Directorate approved the SAAP for an amount of **Rs. 12252.630 Lakhs** against the resource pool of Rs. 5399.3 lakhs (**Annexure-II**), subject to condition that State Government has to fulfill the conditions as stipulated in guidelines issued by Department of Expenditure from time to time regarding procedure for release of funds under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) and monitoring utilization of the funds. The detailed component/activity wise approval of the Mission Directorate meeting is enclosed below (**Annexure-III**).
