Revised Minutes of the Mission Directorate Meeting of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2024-25 of Goa.

The Mission Directorate Meeting of National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2024-25 was held on 18th October 2024 at 11.30 A.M. at Charak, Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha, Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India, to discuss the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of State Government of Goa.The list of the participants is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

- 2. At the outset, Ms.KavitaGarg, Joint Secretary, Ayush welcomed the representatives of State Government to the Mission Directorate meeting and briefed that the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of Goa had already been appraised during the Appraisal Committee meeting and detailed observations and recommendations were communicated in principle to the State Govt. of Goa. Further, it was also informed to the Mission Directorate that during the Appraisal Meeting, a detailed review of progress of Expenditure had been carried out. It was suggested by Joint Secretary that as per issued guidelines of Dept. of Expenditure, State/UT Governments has to fulfil the following pre-conditions to get grants under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of NAM.
 - (i) Achievement of 75% of expenditure.
 - (ii) Submission of at least 75% of utilization certificates against the UCs due
 - (iii) Funds available in the bank account of SNA is to be less than 12.5% of the total approval including State Share.
 - (iv)State/UT has to release both Central and State share within 30 days to SNA and interest will be charged beyond lapse of 30 days.
 - (v) No funds lying in Treasury
 - (vi) Refund of accrued interest

In this regard, it was observed that Goa State will have to fulfill condition (ii) &(iii) to be eligible for availing of Grant -in -Aid. In this regard, State Government of Goa has informed that compliance for eligibility for Grant in Aid will be completed as early as possible.

- 3. The Mission Directorate reviewed the implementation of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) activities under State Government of Goa. Details of review are as follows:
 - (i) Overall Release, Expenditure and Utilization Certificates status was reviewed and observations are as follows:

- a. Status of Expenditure: Under NAM, an amount of Rs. 3874.844 lakh (Centre Share Rs.2324.906 lakh and State Share –Rs. 1549.938 lakh) has been sanctioned from the year 2014-15 to 2023-24. State Government has reported expenditure of Rs. expenditure of Rs. 3492.83 lakh (90.14%) including refund [Rs. 2122.893 lakh (91.31 %) against central share and Rs. 1369.934 lakh (88.39%) against State share] to the Ministry.
- b. Status of Utilization Certificates: State has submitted UCs for an amount ofRs. 1415.49 lakh (71.14%) against the UCs due of Rs.1989.69 lakh.
- (ii) **Balance in SNA** as on 17.10.2024 Rs. 345.01 lakhs
- (iii) Status of Ayushman Aarogya Mandir (Ayush):
 - i. Total No. of AAM- Ayush Units approved: 100
 - ii. Total No. of AAM- Ayush Units functional: 100
 - iii. Out of 100 AAM(Ayush), 51 units are in Functional Stage-I & 49 units are in Functional Stage-II
 - iv. NABH Assessment and Entry Level Certification: NABH Assessment done in 14 AAM (Ayush) and certification achieved in 6 AAM. State Government was requested to explore the possibilities to achieve NABH Ayush Entry Level Certification (AELC) for all AAM(Ayush).
 - 4. During Mission Directorate, discussion was held with State representatives of Goa based on the recommendations of the Appraisal Committee regarding State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of State Government of Goafor the year 2024-25. Accordingly, Mission Directorate approved the SAAP of total Rs. 2035.591(Rs. 1221.354 lakh as Central Share and Rs. 814.2362 lakh as State Share)against the resource pool of Rs. 1568.79lakhs, (Annexure-II) subject to condition that State Government has to fulfill the conditions as stipulated in guidelines issued by Department of Expenditure from time to time regarding procedure for release of funds under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) and monitoring utilization of the funds. The detailed component/activity wise approval of the Mission Directorate meeting is enclosed below (Annexure-III).
