<u>MINUTES for the Mission Directorate Meeting (Video Conference) of National AYUSH</u> <u>Mission (NAM) for the year 2021-22</u>

1. The Mission Directorate Meeting (Through Video Conference) of the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) for the year 2021-22 was held on 15-12-2020 under the Chairmanship of Shri Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha, Secretary, AYUSH, to consider the Supplementary State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) of Uttar Pradesh & **Puducherry**. List of the participants is enclosed at **Annexure-I.**

2. At the outset, Shri D.Senthil Pandiyan, Joint Secretary, AYUSH welcomed the representatives of State/UT Governments to the Mission Directorate meeting and briefed that the Supplementary State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) for the State/UT Govt. of Uttar Pradesh & Puducherry have already been appraised during the Appraisal Committee meeting and detailed observations were communicated to the States/UTs.

3. After that a brief presentation has been made by Deputy Advisor (Ayu) for each State highlighting the aspects of

- i. Year-wise Progress of expenditure and status of UCs submitted under NAM
- ii. Status of AYUSH HWCs
- iii. Status of setting up of upto 50 Bedded integrated AYUSH Hospitals
- iv. Status of New AYUSH Educational Institution.
- v. Status of approved SAAP during 2021-22.
- vi. Status of Submitted Supplementary SAAP for the year 2021-22
- vii. Status of implementation of PFMS.

ANNEXURE-II

PUDUCHERRY

Mission Directorate reviewed the Expenditure & Utilization Certificates status of the U.T. Govt. against the previous year's grants-in-aid released to the State under the NAM scheme, Status of PFMS, Status of HWCs, Status of State Annual Action Plan and additional proposal made the following observations and recommendations:

Expenditure & Utilization Certificates

- Status of Expenditure: Under NAM, an amount of Rs.1445.606 Lakhs has been approved from the year 2014-15 to 2020-21. U.T. Govt. has reported an expenditure of Rs.1345.21 lakhs (93.06%). Further, it is observed that Rs. 1.87 lakhs of State share for the year 2020-21 is lying pending with State Treasury. In this regard, U.T. Govt. has informed that they will look into matter and take necessary steps for the expedition of State Share.
- Status of Utilization Certificates: U.T. Govt. has submitted Utilization Certificates (UCs)for Rs. 1237.133 Lakhs (93.57%) till date. U.T. Govt. is required to submit UCs of Rs. 85.05 lakhs against UC due (Central Share).

Status of State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of the year 2021-22

- Mission Directorate approved different activities of the SAAP including AYUSH Health & Wellness Centres (HWCs) for an amount of Rs.508.70Lakhs (Rs. 305.22 Lakhs as Central share and Rs. 203.48 Lakhs as State Share).
- As per the direction of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India,25% of approved Central Share i.e. Rs. 76.305 Lakhs has been released for different activities of SAAP including AYUSH HWCs as 1st installment vide Sanction Orders No. S-16012/3/2021-NAM (Part) dated 08-11-2021 with a request to withdraw the released 25 % amount of Central share along with matching State Share from treasury to State AYUSH Society and utilize the 75% of the released amount, so that the subsequent installment of balanced approved Central Share may also be released to the State Government.
- iii. However, till date communication from UT Govt. regarding the withdrawal of released grant-in –aid and its utilization is awaited.
- iv. In this regard UT Govt. has informed that they will necessary steps for the transfer of released fund and its utilization and will intimate to the Ministry at the earlies

physical & financial progress report
submitted by U.T. Govt. as on

U.T.Govt. has made an expenditure of
Rs.390.90 Lakhs. Accordingly, it
appears that an amount of Rs. 25.61
Lakhs is lying unspent with the U.T.
Govt. Further, it is pertinent to mention
here that Ministry of AYUSH has
released an amount of Rs. 302.74
Lakhs(Non-recurring) for Setting up of
upto 50-bedded integrated AYUSH
Hospital at YANAM from the year
2018-19 to 2020-21. However, as per
the physical & financial progress report
submitted by U.T. Govt. as on
31/10/2021, it is observed that U.T. has
made expenditure of Rs. 302.74 Lakhs.
Accordingly, it appears that no amount
is lying unspent with U.T. Govt.
