#### Minutes of the Mission Directorate Meeting of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2023-24 of Tamil Nadu

The Mission Directorate Meeting of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2023-24 was held through VC on 25-09-2023 under the Chairmanship of Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha, Secretary, Ayush to consider the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of Tamil Nadu. List of the participants is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

- 2. At the outset, Smt. Kavita Garg, Joint Secretary, Ayush welcomed the representatives of State Government of Tamil Nadu to the Mission Directorate meeting and briefed that the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) for the State of Tamil Nadu have already been appraised during the Appraisal Committee meeting and detailed observations were communicated to the State. Joint Secretary complemented to Tmt. Mythili K. Rajendran, Commissioner (Ayush), Government of Tamil Nadu for successful arrangement and completion of Regional Review Meeting under NAM at Chennai dated 05.09.2023.
- 3. While considering the proposal, Mission Directorate made observations/suggestions that Tamil Nadu State has to submit the Detail Project Reports, Ownership of Land and Commitment for creation of regular posts of Integrated Ayush Hospitals and Ayush Educational Institutions. State Government has not uploaded their revised SAAP through NAM portal. In this regard, it has been suggested to upload the revised SAAP after corrections immediately. In this regard, State Government informed that revised SAAP will be submitted immediately on NAM Portal. Further, It was decided in the meeting that the proposed 38 units ASHU Wellness Centres may be linked with Ayush Health and Wellness Centers (HWCs) and increase the total approved HWCs accordingly. However, subsequently the State Government of Tamil Nadu, through mail, has again requested to consider the proposal as per the proposed activity in the SAAP 2023-24 under Flexi-pool Component ensuring that they will explore the possibility of these centers linking with their ongoing initiative of Ayush Health and Wellness Centers (HWCs) due to the unique nature of this activity and the distinct geographical locations of the Wings. After considering that, the Mission Directorate has approved Rs 228 Cr against 38 units of ASHU under flexipool this year as sought by Tamil Nadu, with the suggestion to link it with Ayush Health and Wellness Centers (HWCs) in the SAAP of next year. Moreover, as against the proposed amount of Rs 583 lakhs for medicines, the Mission Directorate has considered Rs. 200.00 lakhs only.
- 4. After considering the SAAP of Tamil Nadu, Mission Directorate **approved** the SAAP for an amount of **Rs. 11059.622 lakhs** (Centre Share **Rs. 6635.773 lakhs** and State share **Rs. 4423.849 lakhs**) for release of funds under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS). The detailed component/activity wise approval of Mission Directorate is attached as **Annexure-II.**
