#### Minutes of the Mission Directorate Meeting of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2023-24 of Uttar Pradesh.

The Mission Directorate Meeting of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) for the year 2023-24 was held through VC on 21-8-2023 under the Chairmanship of Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha, Secretary, Ayush to consider the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of Uttar Pradesh. List of the participants is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

- 2. At the outset, Smt. Kavita Garg, Joint Secretary, Ayush welcomed the representatives of State Government of Uttar Pradesh to the Mission Directorate meeting and briefed that the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) for the State of Uttar Pradesh have already been appraised during the Appraisal Committee meeting and detailed observations were communicated to the State.
- 3. While considering the proposal, Mission Directorate made some observations / suggestions as under:
- i. Uttar Pradesh State has to focus to reduce their SNA balance so as to become eligible for release of grant-in aid.
- ii. Submission of at least 75% of utilization certificates against the UCs due
- iii. Upload legacy data before August 2023.
- 4. During the meeting, it was observed that "Balance in the bank account of SNA" is Rs. 19717.64 Lakhs as on 21.08.2023. Further, it was highlighted by the State Govt. that some amount has been utilized for procurement of Medicines which was originally approved for different activities of SAAPs of previous years, to cope up with the emergent situation which arose due to COVID-19. Chairman, Mission Directorate agreed that during Covid-19 crisis, many decisions had to be taken telephonically at that time for procurement of medicines to meet the exigencies. Subsequently, written communications received from the State Govt. have been noted. During discussions, the Mission Directorate however, observed that there is some confusionin the financial figures regarding specific proportion of State and Central funds which were actually used for purchase of medicines. Further, it was also felt necessary that the whole status of the following needs to be reconciled by the Central and State NAM units and as such Chairman, Mission Directorate had desired to do the needful to come to a logical conclusion by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023:-
  - (i) Released funds utilized for original purpose
  - (ii) Released funds utilized for different purpose from the originally scheduled activity
  - (iii) UC submitted and liquidated with reference to each activity

5. After considering the SAAP of Uttar Pradesh, recommendations of the Appraisal Committee, discussions held during the meeting, Mission Directorate approved the SAAP for an amount of Rs.41395.325 lakhs(Centre Share – Rs.24837.195 lakhs and State share – Rs.16558.13lakhs)subject to the condition that the State Government has to fulfill conditions as stipulated in guidelines issued by Department of Expenditure from time to time regarding procedure for release of funds under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) and monitoring of utilization of the funds. The detailed component/activity wise approval of Mission Directorate is attached as Annexure –II.
