

**MINUTES OF 3<sup>rd</sup> MISSION DIRECTORATE MEETING OF NATIONAL AYUSH MISSION (NAM) FOR THE YEAR 2018-19 HELD ON 05.09.2018 at 11.00 A.M. IN THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH, AYUSH BHAWAN, INA, NEW DELHI.**

A meeting of the Mission Directorate under National AYUSH Mission (NAM) for the year 2018-19 was held in the Conference Hall, Ground Floor, Ministry of AYUSH at 11.00 A.M. on 05.09.2018 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (AYUSH).

2. The Mission Directorate considered the recommendations of the Appraisal Committee of NAM for the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) received from the States/UTs for the year 2018-19. The list of participants is at **ANNEXURE-II**.

3. The Mission Directorate considered the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs), for the year 2018-19 received from the States/UTs of **Jammu and Kashmir, Uttarakhand, Tripura, Rajasthan, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Himachal Pradesh, Lakshadweep and West Bengal**.

4. At the outset, Joint Secretary (RJ) gave a brief account on the National AYUSH Mission(NAM) which envisages provisions for AYUSH Services, development of AYUSH Institutions, quality Control of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy (ASU & H) Drugs and Medicinal Plants. Referring to the implementation of the Mission during last four years, he reminded the State/UT Officials on the importance of timely utilization of the grant released earlier and also submission of the Utilization Certificates which is important for subsequent approval and release of grant/installments under the Mission. It was further informed that till date Rs. 1312.49 crore has been released under National AYUSH Mission to the States/UTs and it is observed that substantial amount is pending from the States/UTs for utilization. It was also emphasized the need of regular submission of the physical and financial progress of activities undertaken under NAM to the Ministry. Joint Secretary further mentioned that the Ministry has undertaken a series of regional review meetings for taking stock of position of the States/UTs in implementing the approved activities. Some States are performing in a better manner delivering AYUSH services to the public. However, much more is required to be done on the ground for expeditious utilization of resources provided under NAM. From the current Financial Year onwards Ministry intends to approve the plan as early as possible and to release funds quickly for timely implementation of the activities.

5. Secretary(AYUSH) expressed the need of outcome oriented effective implementation of the Mission and informed that regular monitoring mechanism set up has been initiated by the Ministry for the effective monitoring of the Mission. Ministry of AYUSH is also in the process of deploying dedicated website for NAM shortly which would serve as an interactive platform for the States/UTs to share their progress and achievements made under NAM. He also asked the States for expeditious utilization of the limited resources provided to them so that more funds can be sought for the development of AYUSH sector in the States.

6. Secretary, AYUSH suggested that all the States must procure drugs according to the NAM guidelines and SOP for testing of Drugs to ascertain the quality standard should be made by the Ministry of AYUSH. States/UTs should follow these SOP's in periodical testing in ASU&H drugs.

7. After detailed deliberations with the State/UT officials on the proposed SAAP, Mission Directorate approved State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) with certain conditionalities as given at **Annexure-I**.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.

**1. State Annual Action Plan(SAAP) of Jammu & Kashmir for the year 2018-19**

The State Government has submitted the Revised SAAP for an amount of **Rs. 1006.20 Lakhs** under National AYUSH Mission (NAM). **Rs. 804.70 Lakhs** were indicated to them as State resource pool. The submitted SAAP was discussed during the appraisal committee meeting and the Committee recommended the proposal. The recommendation of the Appraisal Committee was discussed by the Mission Directorate.

During the Mission Directorate meeting the State representative was enquired about the Status of expenditure made by the State Government against the total released Grant-in-aid of Rs. 2780.211 lakhs, released as Central Share up to the year 2017-18. In this regard, State representative informed that they have already made an expenditure of Rs. 1333.90 lakhs till date and assured that they will expedite the process of utilization and submit the utilization Certificates as early as possible.

State has submitted additional proposal of **Rs.6.58 lakh** in the Appraisal Committee meeting and new additional proposal for **Rs.431.40 lakhs** vide e-mail dated 28.08.2018. **Rs. 773.60 Lakhs** were indicated to them as State resource pool. The recommendation of the Appraisal Committee was discussed by the Mission Directorate.

During the Mission Directorate meeting the State representative was enquired about the Status of expenditure made by the State Government against the total released Grant-in-aid of Rs. 2240.072 lakhs released as Central Share up to the year 2017-18 . In this regard, the State representative informed that UC of Rs. 252.806 lakhs has already been liquidated. Further they informed that they have already made an expenditure of Rs. 452.80 lakhs till date and assured that they will expedite the process of utilization and submit the utilization Certificates as early as possible. The Mission Directorate also desired that a D.O. letter may be sent to the Health Minister of State Govt. of Tripura from Hon'ble MoS I/C Ministry of AYUSH, requesting them to strengthen the Administrative structure of Tripura.

The representatives of the State Government requested in the meeting to allow them to spend the amount meant for certain activities which are approved in 2017-18 however which was not spent during that particular year. In this regard Mission Directorate directed the State to spent amount for the approved activities and submits the UCs expeditiously.
